



Heat Treatment Liability Release

Valley Pest Control will be performing a heat treatment at the customer's location. This treatment will be capable of generating heat within the structure in excess of 130 degrees F for an extended period of time. Maintaining such a temperature for an extended period of time has some inherent risks to personal property. The customer has been given a pretreatment guide as to their responsibilities prior to the treatment. Valley Pest Control's representative has also discussed the risk with the customer. Valley Pest Control's employees will conduct a pretreatment inspection of the location to determine if it is ready for treatment. Valley Pest Control has the option to postpone treatments if the location is found not to be ready for treatment.

Valley Pest Control and its employees have been trained in the use of heat equipment and will use all reasonable and customary precautions to reduce the risk of damage to the customer's personal property. The customer agrees that Valley Pest Control will not be held liable for any damages to personal property as a result of the heat treatment.

In the event a customer's sprinkler system inadvertently releases due to heat treatment, the customer further releases Valley Pest Control of all liability from any damages that may occur to the structure or the contents in the structure.
